

SHORT ROUTE – LESS THAN 1 MILE



Route Description

This route through Cranbrook Country Park is short (less than 1 mile) and will take you on paved and grassy paths so make sure you are wearing appropriate footwear as the grassy paths can get muddy.

Parking at Cranbrook train station, cross the road opposite the station and enter Cranbrook Country Park via the foot bridge.

Follow the surfaced path on your left, which will lead you through a line of trees and past a fenced off dog-exercise area.

Cross the road at the end of the path and enter the park on the other side of the road. Follow the surfaced path and continue past the orchard on your left.

At the end of the orchard, drop down a short, but steep slope (careful, slippery when wet) and follow the grassy path round the back of the orchard crossing a grass footbridge and continuing straight until you reach the road again and are back at the train station.

Alternatively, you could start at the Younghayes Centre where there is free parking for two hours. Head left out of the Centre carpark and left again down Burrow Fields where you will reach the Park. When the Centre is open, there are toilet facilities available. There is also a café and a Co-operative supermarket located by the car park.
