A few months ago, your organisation or group received grant funding from Cranbrook Town Council.

Yes, due to the receipt of the funding, we were able to replace worn kit and equipment that was in desperate need of a refresh, this allowed us to continue offering a quality training and playing environment for our players.

With the purchase of this additional equipment and kit, we were able to elevate our match day performance and professionality with a clear and large scoreboard to display the score, decent match balls for each game, airhorns for signalling time, and our coaches now can keep their session plans, stats and notes in better order with their clipboards. In all this makes us appear more professional and organised to outsiders, and this has lead to a great uptake in our annual trials this year, as we saw record numbers sign up to our trials.

The additional items should in theory have a lifespan of at least 2 years if not more, we will continue to benefit from these items for our upcoming games and training sessions for a long time to come.
