

COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW

Introduction

Since its creation in 2015, Cranbrook Town Council has been requesting a renewed community governance (i.e. boundary) review for the parish boundary of Cranbrook. The last time the Town Council formally requested this was at the full Council meeting on 19 October 2020 (ref. minute 20/162).

At that meeting, the Council considered the report recommending that a community governance review is undertaken by East Devon District Council relating to the parish boundary of Cranbrook. The supporting documents are circulated again.

Recommendation(s)

To reaffirm Cranbrook Town Council's 2020 request for a community governance review and to write to the Chief Executive of East Devon District Council again to request that a community governance review be conducted to revise the parish boundary of Cranbrook to properly reflect the planned expansion of the town.
